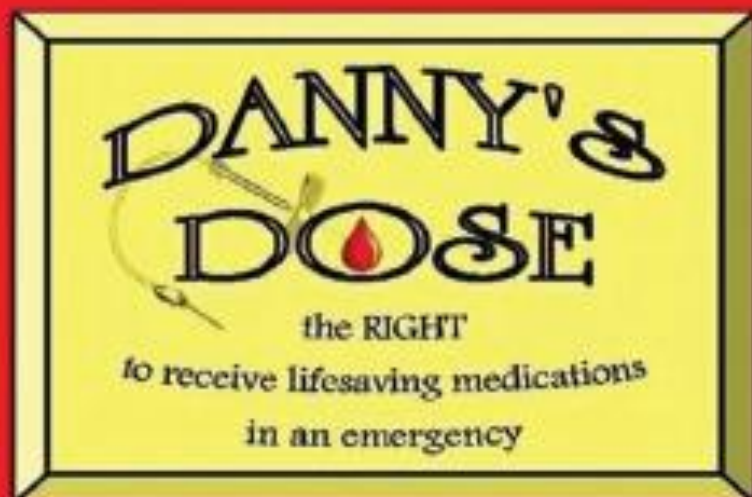

### **Danny's Dose:**

Until October, 2011 our family barely even knew what hemophilia was but learned very quickly when our grandson, Danny Noah, had his first bleed at 10 months old. Our new life with Hemophilia began along with developing an emergency "plan" including a marked car-seat and "Factor backpack" always attached by a carabineer with phone #'s, weight and dosing instructions. However, in April, 2014 our "plan" was crushed when we learned of State Protocols based on National Standards which prohibit Paramedics and E.R. Doctors from administering any medications not in their possession! Yes, we were shocked but soon learned it was very complicated, but true. This oversight ate at us until we realized something must be done, the Protocols must be changed and not just for DANNY, but for all people who carry their own rare, life-saving medications. Those medications only available at approx 2 to 4 hospitals per state! So, DANNY'S DOSE was born in March, 2015 and the campaign started in our home state of Missouri which is currently in the process of amending their protocols and developing specialized training for the paramedics. Although we have learned so much about state level processes, this campaign is really just starting and is bigger than just us. We need people in each state to help. We have a plan of action and are ready to implement it in other states.
